Action Items Discussed:

 - August campout originally planned to be white water rafting. Cannot social distant and wear masks.
 - August 14th at Granogue will be Patrol camping
 - Canoeing is one option
 - Patrols need to plan their activities for this campout
 - September trip was supposed to be a long canoe trip may not happen. Looking at primitive camping ideas nearby that will be patrol based.
