### **Spirit Meter**

ASPL's will be doing the Spirit Meter on Monday night meeting

Leaders / Patrol Advisers will score on Weekend campouts

Each patrol will get their own log; there will be a totem pole for the ranking of the spirit meter

Ex: 1<sup>st</sup> on the totem pole will be the patrol with the highest score on the spirit meter

Change the order of the totem pole once a week, or once a month

Set up a "Spirit Meter Workshop" for patrols to send 2-3 guys to work on their section of the totem pole

Roughly \$120 for all the wood sections of the pole
